Teas Duties

Teas are made on a Rota system. Players making teas are expected to spend **£35** as the visiting side will be required to pay that amount to cover the costs.

Players are asked to buy the teas out of their own money and then be reimbursed once the visiting team has paid.

Making teas includes the following duties before and after the serving of the food

Before:

- 1) Check that Dishwasher has been emptied. If not, please empty it before starting the game
- 2) Make up squash in clear jugs and put in the fridge if possible.
- 3) Get green plastic beakers out of the cupboard.
- 4) Put water in the urn.
- 5) Put urn on at the drinks break.
- 6) Get plates out ready.

After:

- 1) Clean up all rubbish from the pavilion.
- 2) Put all cups and plates in the dishwasher and put it on once full.
- 3) Make sure the kitchen is clean and tidy before leaving.

Make up of teas:

- Remember to buy a 2 pint carton of milk to make tea.
- Aim to buy 4 loaves of bread for the sandwiches.
- Use an assortment of fillings including a **vegetarian** option.
- Buy crisps, biscuits, fruit, sausage rolls, pies, cakes etc to supplement the sandwiches.

Hygiene:

- Please make sure that all surfaces are cleaned down before and after doing teas
- Please wash your hands before preparing teas
- Do not leave food out longer than is reasonably possible

Notes:

- Remember that we now have an oven so you can include hot pizza, quiche etc in your tea spread.
- We already have sandwich trays, sugar, tea bags, juice so you **don't** need to buy these items
- Try to get someone to **help** you as the tasks can be onerous.
- Finally, make sure you **claim** your **£35** back from the WSL captain for the day
